Governor's Newsletter no. 1

District Goals 2018-2020

The district board for the biennium 2018-2020 took office at Convention in Yokohama in July.

The board members are Dorte Olesen, governor, Jane Bordal, It. governor, Aase Schmidt, AD Denmark, Rasa Birutienė, AD Lithuania, Thora Akadóttir, AD Iceland, Elin Hetland Mong, AD Norge, Ellen Skartvedt, treasurer, and Berit Birkelund, secretary. The board held the first meeting in Copenhagen on April 22nd, after attending a joint meeting of the outgoing and the incoming boards of district 13. The board will hold it's second meeting on September 6th in Sauda, in connection with the area meeting in area four, Norway.

The goals for the biennium are in accordance with the Zonta International biennium goals, adopted at convention, covering the 3 areas:

- 1) maximise our impact through service & advocacy and educational programs that empower women and girls,
- 2) strengthen our resources by increasing membership,
- 3) enhance our profile through centennial anniversary activities.

We aim at having all clubs support the international projects via donations - this also goes for the educational programs via the Zonta International scholarships.

We also focus on more collaboration and mutual inspiration between clubs and areas in our district, and to this end we now revitalize the district committees and encourage all clubs to keep in mind to recruit and retain committed and skilled members.

International Liaison

Sigrid Duden is the international liaison to district 13 2018-20. She was governor of district 30 during the biennium 2016-2018 and is now on the Zonta International Board. Professionally Sigrid studied law and has held leadership positions in the City Administration in Heidelberg, Germany.



Young Women in Public Affairs

All clubs in the district are encouraged to invite applications for the Young Women in Public Affairs Scholarships 2019. This program looks to the young women of today - 16-19 years old - as the leaders of tomorrow. There are 10 international scholarships of 4000 USD and 32 district scholarships of 1500 USD, so international winners get altogether 5500 USDollars. The deadline for submission of club winners to the District YWPA Committee is April 1, 2019.

Zonta and the UN

Zonta International works closely with the United Nations on projects advancing the status of women and girls. UN Sustainable Development Goal (SDG) no. 5 is Achieve gender equality and empower women and girls. ZI encourages all clubs to work on endorsing that goal which is completely in line with Zonta's mission of empowering women and girls through service and advocacy. Sadly, the ZC Sandnes and Jæren was disbanded at the end of the 2016-18 biennium.

The district board will have a board meeting in Sauda on September 6, and several board members will attend the ensuing Area meeting, where we will congratulate Zonta Norway with the new ZC Vigrestad og Omegn.

Area 01, Denmark, will have an area meeting late in September, from 21st-23rd, in Karrebæksminde close to Næstved, hosted by ZC Næstved.

District 13 worked hard on increasing the membership in the district and the result for 2016-2018 is positive: we grew by 1.4%, where Zonta globally decreased by 1.9%. Thank you to the Membership Committees at all levels: district, areas and clubs - and keep up the good work!
